HUSKY NO-HITTERS

When Tim Lincecum and Nick Hagadone combined on a no-hit win over Santa Clara in 2006, a number of previous Husky no-hitters that had been lost in history came to light. In fact, four no-hitters that were not listed in the UW or Pac-10 media guides were found, bringing the number of known no-hitters in Husky history to eight. The first was by Bob Peterson in 1951. Peterson fanned seven in a 7-0 beating of Idaho. The next was by George Kritsonis against Seattle Pacific on April 8, 1957. Kritsonis threw a nine-inning game, beating the Falcons 18-0. He struck out 16 and did not allow a runner to reach second base. About a year later, the UW got a seven-inning job thrown by Larry Morrow, who was making his first college pitching appearance. Morrow, a catcher, no-hit Puget Sound, 14-0, on April 21, 1958. He fanned six, walked one and hit one batter, but did not allow a ball out of the infield. He played every position on the field for the Huskies that year. In 1969, Gary Huson added his name to the list with a seven-inning no-hitter, a 6-0 win over San Jose State in UW's season opener. In '74, Steve Bazoski threw another seven-inning no-no, beating Portland, 9-0. In 1978, future major leaguer Rick Anderson threw 10 no-hit innings in a 0-0 tie with Oregon State. The game was halted due to darkness. In 1985, Bob Goucher (4 innings) and Pete Tjaarda (1) combined for a rain-shortened, five-inning no-hitter in a 10-0 win over Seattle U.
