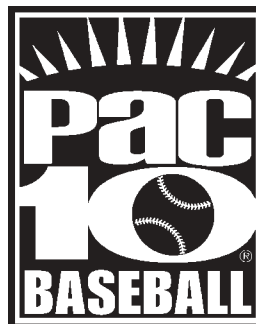

NOTING THE 2003 HUSKIES . . .

BACK TO POSTSEASON: Washington made its seventh trip to the NCAA postseason in 2003, marking their sixth regional appearance since 1992 and their fifth under current head coach Ken Knutson. This time, the Huskies were selected as a third seed and sent to the Long Beach Regional, hosted by Long Beach State. While the Huskies handed Big Ten champion and second-seed Minnesota a pair of losses, they were unable to unseat the hosts, losing to the 49ers twice, including in the championship round. Washington, still the only team from the Pacific Northwest to appear in the NCAAs in the last 12 years, made the championship round for the fourth time despite never having been seeded any higher than third in a regional. Three Huskies were named to the all-tournament team: catcher Aaron Hathaway, third baseman John Otness and center fielder Brent Lillibridge.

MORE POWER: Washington finished No. 2 in the nation in home runs, hitting 96 as a team, second only to perennial home run leader New Mexico State (a beneficiary of high altitude and desert weather). The Huskies saw their single-season home runs record broke as transfer Chad Boudon belted 22 homers, sixth in the NCAA, first in the Pac-10 and three better than the old Husky record of 19, set by Dominic Woody in 1999.

Boudon also became on the second Husky ever to hit three home runs in a game as he pulled off that feat in a 16-3 win over California in a nationally-televised game. The Husky outfield was perhaps the hardest hitting in the country with Boudon (part-time left-fielder and DH) hit 22, right fielder Mike Wagner belted 15 and center fielder Brent Lillibridge set a UW freshman record with 13 on the season.

FENTON, LILLIBRIDGE, BOUDON MAKE ALL-PAC-10:

For the first time since the merger of the Pac-10's two divisions prior to the 1999 season, three Husky players made the All-Pac-10 first team. Sophomore closer Will Fenton was named to the team (as well as third-team All-America) after posting an amazing 0.00 earned run average. The hard-throwing right went 2-0 with a Pac-10-leading 12 saves. He didn't allow a single run in 32.1 innings while surrendering only 16 hits and fanning 49. Chad Boudon, a transfer from Hawaii, led the Pac-10 with 22 home runs, setting a new UW record. He also batted .287 and drove in a team-high 58 runs. Lillibridge had probably the best freshman year in Husky history to make the team. A shortstop by trade, Lillibridge played sparkling center field while batting .388 with 13 home runs and 48 runs batted in. His batting average was second in the nation among freshmen while his slugging percentage (.699) was the best by a freshman.

DRAFTABLE: Washington saw six players selected in the Major League Baseball draft this past June, with five of those six being selected on the first day (first 20 rounds). Junior outfielder Mike Wagner, undrafted out of high school, was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the fifth round. Senior starting pitcher Sean White was picked by the Atlanta Braves in the eighth round and fellow starting rotation-mate, right-handed pitcher Jeff Petersen, was picked in the 11th round by the Giants. Both White and Petersen were drafted in the late rounds out of high school and White turned out the opportunity to sign professionally after his junior year. Senior shortstop Tila Reynolds, who was also drafted following his junior year but elected to return, moved up from his previous round to be taken by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 11th round. Another previously undrafted player, lefty reliever Brian Carter, was selected by the Cubs in the 19th round. Finally, junior outfielder/DH Chad Boudon was picked by Baltimore in the 42nd round.



Mike Wagner helped the Huskies belt 96 home runs last season, adding 15 to that mix. The Dawgs were first in the Pac-10 and second in the nation in homers.

REYNOLDS WRAPS UP CAREER: Senior Tila Reynolds finished his four years as the Huskies' starting shortstop with a long list of accomplishment. Reynolds, who stepped into his starting spot right out of this gates his freshman year, was a fixture there for four season and has the stats to prove it. Reynolds finished his career having played more games (218) than any Husky ever and his 832 career at bats were 144 more than the next player on that list. He also set the school doubles record, with 50 and finished atop the lists in strikeouts (172) and hit by pitch (33). Additionally, he fell only one triple short of the school record and ranked in the top 10 in runs (fourth), hits (third) and stolen bases (ninth).

WHITE IN THE TOP-10: Like classmate Tila Reynolds, Sean White returned for his senior year after being drafted and walked away with his name all over the UW top-10 lists. White, a regular in the rotation his last three seasons as the Husky ace his senior year, closed out his career ranked in the Washington top 10 in the following: appearances (ninth with 53), starts (second with 43), wins (sixth with 19), innings (seventh with 249.1) and strikeouts (fourth with 181).

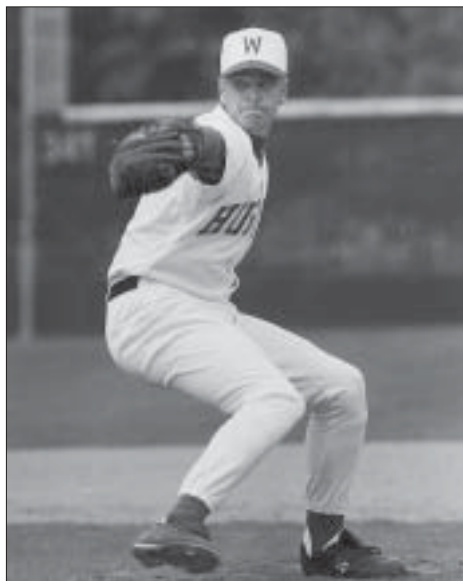

Husky Hall of Famer "Tubby" Graves compiled 209 wins during his 27-year career as baseball coach.

Note on the conferences: Since the 1915-16 academic year, the University of Washington has been a member of what is now called the Pacific-10 Conference. The Husky baseball team has participated in one form or another of this conference since that time, excluding the 1917, 1918, 1924 and 1944 seasons. In 1916, the conference was known as the Pacific Coast Conference, which included California, Washington, Oregon and Oregon State. Other schools joined in the league's infancy: Washington State (1917), Stanford (1918), USC and Idaho (1922), Montana (1924) and UCLA (1928). Montana dropped out in 1950 and the conference maintained its original name until 1958, when it was dissolved and renamed the Athletic Association of Western Universities, consisting of UW, USC, UCLA, Cal and Stanford. WSU rejoined in 1962 and Oregon and OSU came back in 1964, when the league was renamed the Pacific-8 Conference. Arizona and Arizona State joined in 1978 to make it the Pacific-10.

With regard to baseball, the Huskies competed in the PCC until 1923, when it was split into North and South divisions. This format held (with five teams in the North most years) until 1967, when the Pac-8 began play as a whole, a format that lasted only three seasons. From 1970 until 1981, the Northern Division was made up of only four teams. In 1982, a new configuration was formed with a six-team Southern Division (Arizona, ASU, Cal, Stanford, UCLA, USC) and a seven-team Northern Division (UW, OSU, WSU, Eastern Washington, Gonzaga, Portland and Portland State). The inclusion of the four non-traditional teams was necessitated when Oregon dropped its program after the 1981 season. Eastern Washington dropped its program after the 1990 season and Portland and Gonzaga went to the West Coast Conference following 1995.

After the 1998 season, Portland State dropped baseball and in 1999, the conference competed as a whole without divisions for the first time since 1969.

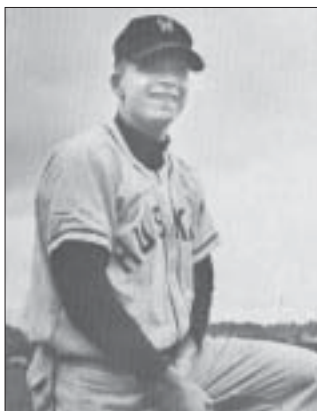

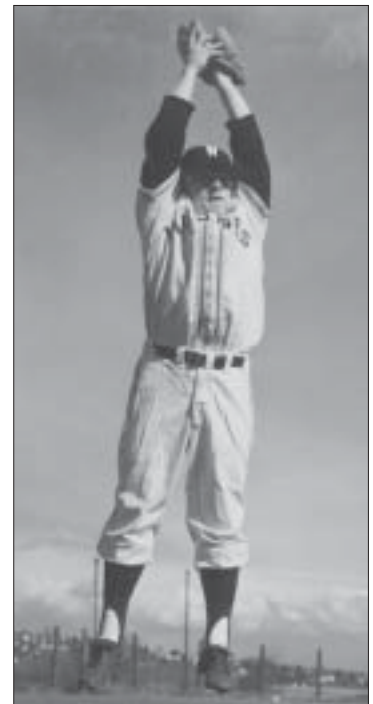
