The Pac-10 resurrected its Conference Tournament in 2002, the league's first postseason championship since 1990. Unlike the previous tournament structure in which all 10 conference teams participated, the current format adds intrigue to the regular season. Only the top eight teams in the final regular season standings will qualify for the tournament. The 2004 Pac-10 Tournment takes place at Staples Center in Los Angeles, Calif. The tournament is scheduled for Thursday, March 10, culminating with the championship game, Saturday, March 12.
