

Pac-10 Tournament History



For the eighth time in its history, and fourth consecutive season, the Pacific-10 Conference will hold a postseason basketball tournament to determine the league's automatic berth in the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament.

The top eight teams in the Pac-10's regular season standings will advance to the 2005 Pac-10 Tournament, scheduled for Thursday-Saturday, March 10-12 at the Staples Center in Los Angeles.

Fox Sports Net will broadcast quarterfinal and semifinal action on March 10-11, while the Championship game will be televised by CBS at 3 p.m. PST on Saturday, March 12.

The original incarnation of the Pac-10 Tournament ran from 1987-90. The inaugural event was held following the 1986-87 season at Pauley Pavilion in Los Angeles. Tournaments were also held in Tucson, Ariz., (1988), Los Angeles (1989), Tempe, Ariz. (1990), and Los Angeles' Staples Center (2002-04) as well.

UCLA captured the first Pac-10 Tournament title on its home court in 1987 before Arizona won four consecutive championships from 1988-1990 and 2002. Oregon won in 2003 and Stanford captured the postseason tournament title last season, courtesy of a 77-66 victory over Washington.

The Huskies advanced to the tournament championship game last spring for the second time. They lost 76-64 to UCLA in the 1987 title contest and fell to Stanford last season.

Prior to announcing the return of the tournament on Oct. 23, 2000, the Pacific-10 Conference was one of just two NCAA Division I leagues (Ivy) in the nation without a postseason tournament.

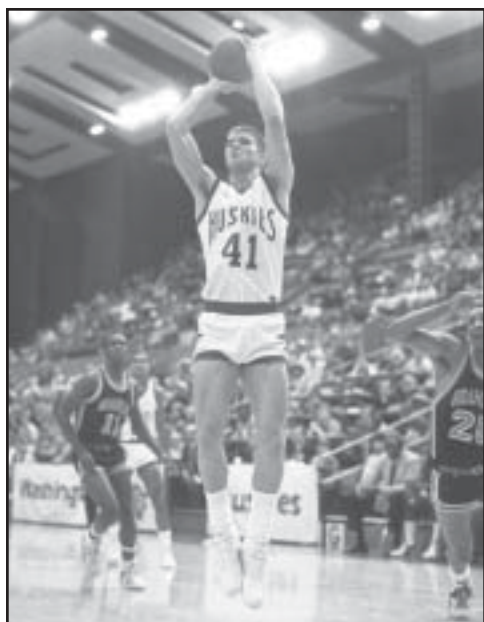

2004-05 Washington Travel Plans

Travel Tidbits

Washington travels by commercial aircraft on all road trips except the Oregon and Washington State trips on which the Huskies travel by bus. Flight information is available prior to each travel week.

Media accompanying the team should make their own travel plans. Washington travel coordinator Mary Ryles (206) 685-0100 sometimes reserves a few extra rooms at each team hotel. Media should call each hotel directly and mention that they cover Washington basketball.

Media should contact Dan Lepse of the UW Media Relations office in advance of road trips concerning game credentials, parking passes and interview requests. Washington players and coaches are sometimes available by request at hotels and sometimes briefly before or after practice, subject to travel itineraries.

Washington's locker room opens up approximately 10 minutes after the game on the road if the visiting locker room area is large enough to accommodate the press. If the locker room facility is too small, other arrangements will be made and announced prior to the game.

Husky Coach Lorenzo Romar has contractual obligations for brief interviews with the Husky Radio Network following all games. He will do his best to work out post-game interviews with other media outlets around those radio obligations.
