Washington lost its season opener at Michigan, 31-29, on a Philip Brabbs 44-yard field goal as time expired. The crowd of 111,491 – largest ever to witness a UW football game – was treated to a back-and-forth classic as the lead changed six times in the second half.

The Huskies trailed 14-0 after two long first-quarter scores by the Wolverines – a 57-yard run by Chris Perry and a 45-yard pass from John Navarre to Braylon Edwards.

Washington, however, closed to within a point at halftime as Cody Pickett hit tight end Kevin Ware with a three-yard pass (the PAT failed) and Rich Alexis ran in a score from six yards out.

In the third quarter, the Huskies took their first lead when Pickett threw into double coverage, but Charles Frederick came up with the ball for a 51-yard TD.

After Perry's two-yard run put the Wolverines back on top, 21-20, John Anderson connected on a 30-yard field goal to give the Huskies a 23-21 edge.

Perry scored his third TD of the day, from three yards out, in the fourth period to put his team in front once again, 28-23, but Alexis carried the ball to the six on a 59-yard run before completing the drive with a one-yard score.

The Huskies' try for two points failed, but they looked to have won the game when backup kicker Troy Nienberg missed a 27-yard field goal with 1:24 left.

Michigan, however, got the ball back, converted on a fourth-and-two and were helped along when, on third-and-10 with less than 10 seconds to go, the Huskies were penalized for having 12 men on the field. The penalty moved the ball to the 27-yard line, setting up Brabbs' last-second heroics.

After a sluggish start, the Huskies rebounded in the second half to hand San Jose State at 34-10 loss in the home opener at Husky Stadium.

The Spartans out-gained Washington, 242-179, in total offense in the first half and went to the intermission with a 10-0 lead thanks to a one-yard run from Ezekiel Staples (which capped a 15-play, 85-yard drive) and a 43-yard field goal from Nick Gilliam. It marked the first time since 1995 that the Huskies had been shut out in the first half of a home game.

However, Washington marched 15 plays on the opening drive of the third quarter and Cody Pickett threw 22 yards to Wilbur Hooks for a score.

After an SJSU three-and-out, the Huskies took the lead when Pickett hit Reggie Williams with a 21-yard TD pass.

After the first of two John Anderson field goals put the Huskies farther in front, Pickett opened the fourth quarter with an 89-yard pass to Williams for another touchdown. The pass play was the longest in UW history.

Defensive tackle Terry Johnson tallied the Huskies' final TD of the contest when he batted and then intercepted a pass in the Spartans' endzone.

Husky tailback Rich Alexis rushed for 125 yards, Williams posted 160 receiving yards and Pickett became the third Husky in history to pass for 300 or more yards in three consecutive games, tallying 347 on the day.

Meanwhile, the Huskies held San Jose State to 29 total yards in the second half, including minus-14 rushing, while piling up 320 second-half yards themselves.

Washington ran its home winning streak to 16 games on a record-setting night at Husky Stadium. The Huskies, despite four turnovers, out-gained the Cowboys, 549-255 in terms of total offense en route to a 38-7 win.

The Huskies set a school record with 36 first downs, while Cody Pickett set new marks for pass completions (34), consecutive 300-yard games (3) and career 400-yard games (2). Washington also didn't punt in the game and committed only one penalty, which came late in the fourth quarter.

The Huskies opened the game with a 67-yard touchdown drive as Pickett ran in from one yard out. It marked the Huskies' first first-quarter points in five games. The Cowboys took advantage of a Husky fumble to tie the score at 7-7 in the second quarter, but a John Anderson field goal and a Rich Alexis rushing TD gave the Huskies a 17-7 halftime lead.

The Huskies pulled away in the third quarter on another TD run from Alexis and a scoring pass from Pickett to Paul Arnold.

Early in the fourth quarter, Pickett hit Patrick Reddick with an eight-yard TD pass to cap a night that saw him complete 34-of-45 passes for 404 yards and no interceptions. Alexis ran for 94 yards and two TDs and also shattered career highs with seven receptions for 55 yards.

Reggie Williams turned in his second straight 100-yard receiving day, catching six balls for an even 100 yards. Washington also had a good day defensively, racking up eight sacks and 14 tackles for loss while allowing Wyoming into the red zone only once in the game.

Washington's 2002 aerial assault, piloted by junior quarterback Cody Pickett, continued its flight in a 41-27 win over Idaho in the season's final non-conference game. The Huskies tied a modern school record with their 17th consecutive home victory while Pickett added to several of his records, completing 32-of-44 passes for 438 yards, no interceptions and three touchdowns.

In doing so, Pickett became the first Husky ever to pass for 400 yards in two straight games and extended his consecutive 300-yard games. His 74-yard, highlight-reel TD pass to Charles Frederick extended his career record for 70-yard passes to five.

The Huskies took command in the first half, vaulting to a 28-3 lead at the intermission. After fumbling the ball inside the Vandals' 20, the Huskies returned the favor on the second play of the ensuing Idaho drive as safety Greg Carothers returned a fumble 25 yards

for a score. Early in the second quarter, a three-yard pass from Pickett to Kevin Ware capped a 13-play, 90-yard scoring drive.

Frederick, whose cutback-filled run after catching a short pass was the game's highlight, scored from 74 yards out to make it 21-0. Ware caught his second TD of the day on a nine-yard pass to cap the Huskies' first-half scoring. The Vandals avoided the halftime shutout when Keith Stamps connected on a 49-yard field goal as time expired in the second quarter. Idaho came out in the third quarter and scored on a 16-yard pass from Brian Lindgren to Chris Belser.

John Anderson made a 20-yard field goal for the Huskies and Stamps hit from 32 yards out before a two-yard TD run from Rich Alexis made the Huskies' lead 38-13, essentially putting the game away. Idaho scored two more TDs in the fourth quarter and Anderson hit a second field goal to close out the scoring.

Despite yet another high-flying game from the Husky passing attack, Washington saw its 17-game home winning streak (which tied a modern UW record) snapped as California beat the Huskies, 34-27. The win was the Bears' first over Washington since 1976, a span of 19 Husky wins.

While Cal QB Kyle Boller couldn't match Husky signal-caller Cody Pickett in terms of yardage, he made up for it by throwing for five touchdowns. Boller completed 13-of-24 for 266 yards and no interceptions. The five TDs were third most in Cal history and tied for most ever by a Husky opponent.

Pickett, who had his school-record fifth straight game with 300 or more passing yards, broke his own UW record with 35 completions. But he was unable to complete any of those 35 for a touchdown while compiling 399 yards and two interceptions.

Cal opened the scoring in the first when Boller's flea-flicker pass to Jonathan Makonnen went for a 40-yard TD. Husky senior tailback Braxton Cleman, in his first start since 2000, ran in from 21 yards out to tie the score and the Huskies finished the first quarter with a 10-7 lead after John Anderson hit his first of four field goals on the day from 51 yards.

In the second period, the Bears got a second touchdown pass to Makonnen and a 55-yard score from Boller to Vincent Strang while Anderson's two field goals accounted for a 21-16 Bears lead at the half.

Down 34-18 in the fourth quarter, the Huskies looked like they might work some of the magic that has marked the UC-UW series in recent years, but after Pickett's one-yard TD run and an Anderson field goal with 1:54 left drew the Huskies within a touchdown, the Dawgs were unable to recover an onside kick and the Bears ran out the clock.

An 80-yard strike from Cody Pickett to Reggie Williams with only 2:03 left in the game salvaged a Husky win as Washington worked fourth quarter magic to beat Arizona in dramatic fashion for the third season in a row.

The Wildcats, behind a 443-yard passing day by Puyallup, Wash., native Jason Johnson, took a 28-26 lead early in the fourth quarter after Johnson hit Bobby Wade with a 28-yard TD pass.

The Huskies then had a field goal blocked with 6:48 left and needed to make a defensive stand to get the ball back.

After stopping the 'Cats at the 35-yard line and watching a punt go for a touchback, the Huskies took over on their own 20. After an incomplete pass on first down,

Pickett audibled into a short slant pattern to Williams, who caught the throw and out-raced the Arizona defense 80 yards into the endzone.

Pickett finished the day with 345 yards on 25-of-35 passing with no interceptions and three touchdowns. Williams caught eight balls for 184 yards and three TDs, becoming the first UW receiver to catch three touchdowns in a game since 1991.

Wade and Andrae Thurman were the primary benefactors of Johnson's great success. Wade caught 10 passes for 155 yards and Thurman had nine receptions for 142.

The Husky defense, despite allowing the high passing total, was solid against the run, allowing only 23 yards and also sacked Johnson five times.

Washington's air attack broke more records, but in the end it wasn't nearly enough as the 19th-ranked Trojans rolled to a 41-21 win. Cody Pickett, only seven games into the season, broke the UW single-season record for passing yardage, adding 350 more to his total to surpass Cary Conklin's 1989 record.

Pickett completed 34 of his 61 pass attempts with two interceptions and three touchdowns while tailback Braxton Cleman set a new Husky record with 15 receptions. Reggie Williams had his school-record eighth 100-yard receiving game and his record-tying third straight with 134 yards and a score on seven catches.

However, the Huskies were held to minus-five rushing yards and the Trojans threw for 348 in a game that was never very close. Washington seemed to get a break on the game's first play when first-time starter Sam Cunningham (in for injured regular CB Roc Alexander) picked off a pass from USC QB Carson

Palmer. However, the Huskies' field goal attempt on the ensuing drive was blocked. After an exchange of punts, Palmer hit Mike Williams for the first of three Williams TDs on the day, this time from 43 yards out.

The Huskies scored on a five-yard pass from Pickett to Paul Arnold, but Palmer struck back, hitting Keary Colbert for a 61-yard score. A pair of Ryan Killeen field goals and two more TDs by Williams gave USC a 34-7 lead at the end of three quarters, but the Huskies made things interesting in the fourth when Pickett threw touchdowns to Ware and Reggie Williams.

The Huskies' next drive after the Williams TD, however, ended on a fourth-down incomplection and the Trojans put the game away when tailback Justin Fargas ran in from 13 yards out. Palmer finished 21-for-34 for 348 yards and four touchdowns while both Mike Williams (159) and Keary Colbert (146) surpassed 100 yards receiving.

What looked as though it would be an offensive shootout more closely resembled a defensive battle as red-hot Arizona State remained unbeaten in conference play with a 27-16 win over the Huskies at Sun Devil Stadium.

After watching Husky QB Cody Pickett break the UW single-season passing record in only the seventh week of the season and ASU's Andrew Walter break the single-game Pac-10 passing yards record the Saturday before, fans were looking for an aerial shootout.

However, Pickett passed for a season-low 210 yards as the Huskies compiled only 252 yards of total offense. Walter passed for only 184 yards and the Devils amassed only 229 total yards. ASU jumped out to a lead thanks to two first-quarter touchdowns from Hakim Hill, brother of former Washington standout Lonzell Hill. The younger Hill ran in a score from one yard out on

the Devils' first possession and then caught a nine-yard TD pass for the second.

A 40-yard field goal from John Anderson late in the second quarter made it 14-3 at the half. The Devils put the game away in the second half when Walter hit Shaun McDonald with a 15-yard TD pass and Mike Barth connected on two field goals to stretch the Devils' lead to 27-3.

Washington got late TDs on a 38-yard pass to Paul Arnold and a one-yard run from Chris Singleton.

ASU defensive end Terrell Suggs posted four and a half sacks on the day as the Devils' pressure on Pickett was probably the most important aspect of the game. As a team, Arizona State compiled eight sacks and a total of 17 tackles for loss.

The Huskies dropped their third straight game despite a late comeback try as UCLA came away from Husky Stadium with a 34-24 win.

Trailing nearly the entire game, the Huskies got back to within a field goal when quarterback Cody Pickett hit Paul Arnold with a 66-yard TD pass with 8:36 remaining in the fourth quarter. However, Pickett was intercepted by Spencer Havner on the next drive and Havner returned the pick 42 yards for a score to put the game away.

The game was mostly close throughout. After Nate Fikse hit his first of two field goals in the first quarter, the Huskies responded when Pickett connected with Reggie Williams on a 13-yard score.

UCLA went back in front on the first of three Tyler Ebell one-yard TD runs. Ebell scored again in the second

quarter, taking advantage of the first of four Pickett interceptions. After Pickett hit tight end Kevin Ware with a 20-yard score to draw the Huskies to within three points again at 17-14, Ebell sent the Bruins to the locker room with a 24-14 lead after third first-half score.

Fikse and John Anderson traded second-half field goals before Arnold's long catch and run closed the gap. UCLA freshman QB Drew Olson, in his first career start, went 13-for-27 for 189 yards while classmate Ebell ran for 102 yards.

The Huskies, who outgained the Bruins 498-316 (in terms of total offense) got 92 rushing yards from sophomore Chris Singleton, who was also starting for the first time. Pickett went 29-for-60 for 429 yards and three touchdowns, but threw a season-high four interceptions. Arnold finished the game with five catches for 148 yards.

Washington's defense led the way with five interceptions, including two returned for TDs, as the Huskies broke a three-game losing streak with a 41-29 win over Oregon State.

After falling behind 10-3 on a 60-yard pass from OSU's Derek Anderson to James Newson, the Huskies tied the game on an 11-yard pass from Cody Pickett to Reggie Williams, which came after the first of two interceptions by Derrick Johnson.

Johnson then gave the Huskies the lead when he ran back his second pick 42 yards for a score with 22 seconds left in the first quarter.

In the second, Chris Massey took a pick back 25 yards

for a TD to bump the Husky lead to 24-10.

OSU closed the gap to 24-22 thanks to Kirk Yliniemi's second and third field goals of the day and a 13-yard TD run by Steven Jackson, who finished with 135 yards on 35 carries.

But two one-yard scoring runs from Rich Alexis stretched the lead to 38-22. Jackson scored from a yard out to cut the gap, before John Anderson booted a 52-yard field goal to close out the scoring.

OSU entered the game ranked No. 1 in the Pac-10 in scoring defense at 15.9 points per game. Pickett took over the UW career passing yards No. 1 spot with 262 on the day.

After falling behind 14-0 with 6:09 left in the first quarter, Washington dominated the 23rd-ranked Ducks the rest of the way, cruising to a 42-14 win in front of an Autzen Stadium record 57,112 fans.

The Husky defense allowed only 122 yards over the final three and a half quarters and held the Ducks to no yards in the fourth period. Cody Pickett, who broke the Pac-10 season passing yards record, threw for 316 yards and four TDs on 26-of-37 passing while Reggie Williams had a career day with 14 catches for 198 yards and three touchdowns.

Williams broke the school's single-season receptions record and career receiving yardage mark.

Down 14-0, the Huskies drove 67 yards and scored late in the first on a five-yard Rich Alexis run. The score was tied at 14-14 at the half after Pickett hit Williams

with a 23-yard scoring pass in the second.

After the break, Derrick Johnson recorded his second interception of the day and, on the ensuing play, Alexis scored on an option play from 13 yards out.

After a UW fumble recovery on a punt, Pickett threw to Patrick Reddick for a six-yard score. Williams scored on 47 and 41-yard passes in the fourth to put the game away.

Washington rushed for a season-high 163 yards on the day, with Alexis gaining 122 on 30 carries. UW also possessed the ball for 40:09 of the game's 60 minutes (Oregon had 19:51).

Additionally, Husky sophomore punter Derek McLaughlin broke his own record (74 yards) with an 80-yard punt in the first quarter.

Washington shocked No. 3 Washington State in the annual Apple Cup game, handing the Cougars a three-overtime, 29-26 loss to wrap up the regular season with consecutive wins over its three Northwest rivals.

Down 20-10 with 4:30 to play in the fourth quarter, the Huskies drove 92 yards in only six plays and 1:28 and Paul Arnold scored on a seven-yard pass from Cody Pickett to draw the UW within a field goal.

On the ensuing drive, Husky freshman cornerback Nate Robinson intercepted a pass from backup WSU quarterback Matt Kegel on the second play of the Cougars' drive and John Anderson hit a 25-yard field goal with 15 seconds left in regulation to send the game into overtime.

Kegel was in the game after WSU starter Jason Gesser suffered a leg injury on a third-quarter sack from Husky

DT Terry Johnson, one of six UW sacks on the day.

Neither team's offense was able to accomplish much in the overtime periods as Anderson and WSU kicker Drew Dunning exchanged field goals in the first two extra frames.

After Anderson hit a 49-yarder to open the third overtime, the Huskies won the game when, on WSU's second play, defensive end Kai Ellis batted down and recovered what was ruled a backwards pass from Kegel.

Pickett became the first Pac-10 passer ever to throw for 4,000 yards in a season, notching 368 on the day. Reggie Williams, who was held to only two receptions in the first half, finished with 12 on the day, breaking his own Apple Cup record (11), set the previous year. Anderson tied a UW record with five made field goals on the day, and set a record with eight attempts.

After jumping out to a quick 17-0 lead, Washington could not sustain its momentum and fell to Purdue 34-24 in the 2002 Sun Bowl. Ironically, it was the same score the Huskies defeated the Boilermakers by in the 2001 Rose Bowl.

The Huskies looked like they were going to stretch their late-season winning streak to four games when Washington quarterback Cody Pickett hooked up with wide receiver Pat Reddick for a seven-yard scoring pass just five minutes into the game. Just 1:33 later Washington inside linebacker Marquis Cooper scooped up a fumble and returned it 31 yards for a score.

John Anderson's 38-yard field goal with 3:49 left in the first quarter put the Huskies up 17-0.

The Boilermakers finally got on the scoreboard with

5:09 to play in the half when John Sandeford caught a seven-yard touchdown from Purdue quarterback Kyle Orton. After holding the Huskies on downs, Purdue marched 66 yards during the final two minutes of the half, closing the Huskies' lead to three points when Boilermaker wide receiver Ray Williams recovered a teammate's fumble in the endzone for a score.

Purdue kept up its scoring streak in the third quarter with a 22-yard field goal by Berin Lacevic, a 10-yard touchdown run by Joey Harris and a 19-yard fumble recovery for a touchdown by Gilbert Gardner.

The Boilers capped their scoring with another field goal by Lacevic with 5:52 to play to extend their lead to 34-17. UW's Pat Reddick caught a 12-yard touchdown pass from Pickett with 3:31 to play. The Huskies had a chance to get within a touchdown late, but Anderson's field goal attempt hit the goal post.
