

**20/20 Hindsight:** The 2005-06 season for Washington men's tennis will go down as one of the best in school history. Not only did the Huskies advance to their fifth NCAA Round of 16 in six years, they recorded their second-consecutive season with 20 wins. The last time the Huskies recorded back-to-back 20 win seasons was exactly 20 seasons prior in 1985 (20-8) and 1986 (26-7). Washington finished the year with a 20-6 record, its six losses coming to Top-25 opponents. The 20-win season marked the third under head coach Matt Anger and eighth in school history. The Huskies earned their way into the NCAA Sweet 16 with regional wins over Penn State and Virginia Commonwealth University, before falling to the fourth-ranked and fifth-seeded Baylor Bears.

**French Connection:** Much of the Huskies' success this year can be credited to the addition of French exchange students Pierre Metenier and Jean-Noel Insausti. The pair joined the team in January and made contributions immediately, stepping into the second and third positions in the singles lineup. Insausti was 17-6 in singles during season, going 6-0 in the No. 2 position and 10-5 at No. 3. He was named the Pac-10 Player of the Week after picking up back-to-back third-set tiebreak wins versus USC and UCLA, including an upset over No. 78 Mathieu Dehaine to clinch UW's win over then-No. 7 UCLA. Insausti has also impacted the doubles lineup, pairing with Mike Ricks to solidify the third position in the lineup, going 14-12 overall. Metenier was 16-6 overall in singles, including a 14-4 mark in the No. 2 slot. He finished his short Husky career by winning 10 of his last 11 matches including three wins over ranked opponents.

**Huskies Sweep LA Schools:** The Huskies came into the season with a 1-22 all-time record against UCLA and a 3-20 record against USC. The Huskies managed to put the past behind them for one magical weekend in Seattle and swept the LA schools for the first time in UW history. The Huskies started the week by beating USC 4-3 in front of the Husky partisan crowd. After dropping the doubles point, Alex Slovic swept the No. 1 singles match to even up the score. USC won the No. 6 match to take the lead, before the UW got three-set victories from the French Connection--Metenier and Insausti--to put the Huskies within reach of a win over the Trojans. USC took the No. 5 singles match in three sets before Daniel



Chu secured the team victory with an epic three-set win in the No. 4 spot. The very next day the Huskies had to refocus and reenergize as defending National Champions UCLA took the court. Down 0-1 after losing the doubles point, the Dawgs rallied to win four of the six singles matches and upset the seventh-ranked Bruins 4-3. Once again the finish was fantastic as the Huskies were trailing 3-2 with just Metenier and Insausti on the court in the middle of three-set matches. Metenier was able to battle back after losing the first set 1-6 to win the next two sets. Out of frustration after the match, Metenier's opponent threw his racquet and received a point violation. The point was given to Insausti, who was in the midst of a third-set tie-breaker that was even at five. The point gave Insausti a 6-5 lead in which he capitalized upon by serving out the match. The win also gave Coach Matt Anger the 200th of his career and kept the Huskies in contention for a second-consecutive Pac-10 title. The only other time the Huskies had defeated UCLA was back in 1998.

**Anger Reaches 200:** Husky head coach Matt Anger reached the 200 win plateau during the 2006 season. He reached the magical number in one of the most memorable matches in Husky history (see above). The Huskies beat UCLA for just the second time in school history to give Anger No. 200. He is now 203-93 (.686) all-time in 12 seasons at Washington. His win total is tops among all-time UW tennis coaches and his winning percentage is third best among coaches.

**Huskies Tie For Seventh At ITA National Indoor Championships:** The Nordstrom Tennis Center once again played host to the ITA National Indoor Championships in February. Sixteen of the top teams from around the country invaded Seattle for four days, including eventual NCAA national champs Pepperdine and runner up Georgia. The Huskies won their opening match, taking out 11th-ranked Virginia 4-1. It was the third time the Huskies reached the quarterfinals. Washington dropped its next two matches to No. 3 Illinois (4-1) and No. 7 UCLA (4-1). The Huskies tied for seventh place in the tournament, while Georgia defeated Pepperdine in the championship, a match that would prove to be a preview of the NCAA Team Championship Final.

**UW Survives VCU Regional:** The Huskies traveled all the way to Richmond, Va., for the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament and came away with the result they were looking for. In the first round, UW came back from a 1-0 deficit after losing the doubles point to defeat No. 45 Penn State, 4-1. Andy Kuharszky and Klaus Jank pulled out three-set wins to give UW its third and fourth points. Alex Slovic and Pierre Metenier also provided strong wins in the No. 1 and 2 slots. The next day, UW endured two different delays due to rain and lightning to upset 12th-ranked Virginia Commonwealth, 4-0. The initial start time was delayed three hours and then again during singles play the action was moved to an indoor location off campus. Slovic's upset over 15th-ranked Arnaud Leclerc at No. 1 singles clinched the win for the Huskies, marking the second-straight season he clinched the match that sent the Huskies to the Sweet 16.

**Baylor Ends Tourney Run:** The Huskies were once again denied a trip to the NCAA Elite Eight, this time falling in the Sweet 16 to eventual Final Four participant Baylor. The fourth-ranked and fifth-seeded Bears were too much for the Huskies, downing the UW 4-1. The Huskies, who made their fifth Sweet 16 appearance in the last six years, could not replicate the magic of the previous week that propelled them forward in the team competition. Pierre Metenier was the lone Husky to score a point, winning in straight sets from the No. 2 spot.

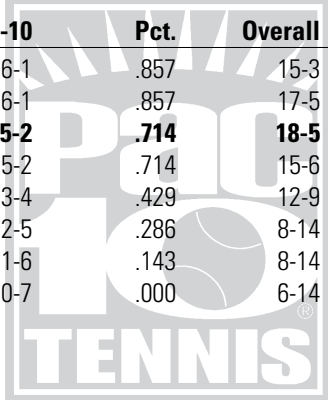
