Records: Mississippi 6-1, Oklahoma State 3-3

Recap: Mississippi advanced to their fifth semifinals appearance at the ITA National Team Indoors today, with their 4-0 win over No. 13 seed Oklahoma State. The Rebels made quick work of the Cowboys, finishing the match in less than three hours. Ole Miss took an early lead with the doubles points, getting wins at No. 2 doubles from Bram ten Berge and Matthias Wellerman, and No. 3 doubles from Robbye Poole and Jakob Klaeson. Wins at Nos. 6, 2 and 4 singles clinched the 4-0 win for Mississippi. Kalle Norberg was the first Rebel to get a win, as he beat Igor Sobolta, 6-1, 6-2. Wellermann followed at No. 2 singles, with a 6-3, 6-4 win over Ivan Puchkarov. And ten Berge clinched the win for Ole Miss, with his 6-1, 7-5 win at No. 4 singles over Nathan Byrnes. Mississippi advances to the semifinals, where they will face off against the winner of the Virginia/UCLA match scheduled to begin at 11 a.m. The Rebels have seen both teams before, in

an identical situation. In 2005, No. 6 seeded Mississippi was upset by an unseeded Virginia team in the semifinals at this tournament, 4-1. And in 2004, it was a No. 6 seed UCLA who knocked out the Rebels in the semis, with a 4-3 win. The semifinal match will take place at 11 a.m. Sunday at Nordstrom Tennis Center.
