
### 2004 SEASON REVIEW

Huskies Shine In 2004: The national spotlight shone brightly on Husky men's tennis in 2003-04. With his win in the All-American Championships, the first major of the college tennis season, junior All-American Alex Vlaski grabbed the attention of the tennis world and catapulted himself to an all-time Washingtonhigh No. 2 ranking. Shortly thereafter, the Huskies played host to the ITA National Team Indoor Championships, featuring the nation's top teams including year-end NCAA champion Baylor and runner-up UCLA. A strong showing at the tournament propelled the Huskies to No. 10 in the rankings, their highest all season, but their 4-3 loss to Mississippi in the first round was indicative of the near-misses against top teams that would eventually cost them. Growing pains were to be expected, as the Huskies had three freshmen starting in singles and only one senior on the roster. But the stage was set for great things in 2004-05 and beyond. To cap off the season, freshman Alex Slovic turned heads towards the Northwest once again, being named ITA National Rookie of the Year, and Vlaski became the first ever Husky to earn All-American honors in two seasons.

National Title For Vlaski: A major hallmark for Washington tennis occurred in the fall season when Alex Vlaski became the first Husky national champion since 1924 by winning the ITA All-American Singles Championship. As the fourth seed in the prestigious tournament, Vlaski defeated three players ranked in the top-20 of the ITA rankings en route to the title. In the finals, Vlaski matched up against the nation's top-ranked player, Benedikt Dorsch from Baylor, and prevailed 6-1, 2-6, 6-1, firmly establishing himself as one of the nation's very elite collegiate players. The fall also marked the debut of another future Husky standout from Yugoslavia, freshman Alex Slovic. Teaming with Vlaski, the two won the ITA Regional doubles crown, earning a berth in the National Indoor Championships.

**UW Hosts Nation's Best:** Washington played host to the nation's best teams in the USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Championships early in the season. The Huskies posted a 2-1 record during the tournament, improving their all-time mark to 5-4. The Dawgs held a 3-1 lead against No. 7 Mississippi in the opening round but could not hold on, falling 4-3 for their first loss of the season. They then rebounded with consolation victories over No. 32 Boise State, 4-0, and against 31st-ranked Harvard, 4-2.



Top-ranked Illinois took the title for the second straight year, overcoming the UCLA Bruins, 4-0, in the final.

Close Calls: Only a handful of matches prevented the Huskies from maintaining their stay in the top-10. Washington dropped five matches by 4-3 margins, including heartbreakers against No. 7 Mississippi, No. 8 Rice, and No. 3 USC. "Last year there were a couple spots where we were struggling and it just made all the matches so close," said Head Coach Matt Anger." "Over time it's a little tough because you almost have that feeling that you're starting behind."

**Doubles Switch:** One of the main problems in the close early season losses was doubles play. After starting the season with a 7-1 record, the Huskies dropped three of their next four matches, all losses coming by 4-3 margins. The difference was in the doubles point, where the Huskies lost four in a row and were 6-5 overall. The stretch prompted Head Coach Matt Anger to shake up the doubles lineup, splitting up the No. 1 team of Vlaski and Slovic and teaming Vlaski with Daniel Chu at No. 1, Slovic with Nick Weiss at No. 2 and moving Christoph Palmanshofer and Peter Scharler to No. 3. "We changed our doubles in the middle of the season and it helped us a lot," says Anger. Did it ever. The shift met immediate success as the Huskies went 9-3 in the doubles point the remainder of the season. Washington ended the season with three doubles teams in the final ITA Rankings: Vlaski and Chu (27), Vlaski and Slovic (43), and Slovic and Weiss (56).



Middle of the Pac: After suffering a disappointing 6-1 loss to Stanford in the opening Pac-10 match, the Huskies responded with three-straight conference wins over Cal, Arizona State and Arizona, setting up a showdown with third-ranked USC at home. The Huskies captured the doubles point and the top two singles matches, but USC proved too deep, winning at third through sixth singles and thwarting the UW upset bid. Following a loss to NCAA runner-up UCLA, the Huskies clinched fourth place in the Pac-10 with a 6-1 rout of Oregon that avenged an earlier 4-3 nonconference upset loss to the Ducks. Washington's 4-3 conference mark was a big step up from the previous year's 2-5 record and sixth place conference standing.

Pac-10 Championships: After consecutive runner-up finishes as a freshman and sophomore, Alex Vlaski must have felt long overdue to win his first Pac-10 Championship at Ojai, Calif. last season. Unfortunately, the title eluded him for the third time when Vlaski lost a heartbreaking semifinal to USC's Adriano Biasella, 6-3, 3-6, 7-6 (2). In the second round, Vlaski staged a miraculous comeback over another Trojan, Jamil Al-Agba. After losing the first set 7-5. Vlaski trailed 5-2 in the second set and 5-1 in the third set when he needed an injury timeout to cope with leg cramps, but still rallied to win both sets to take the match 5-7, 7-5, 7-6 (2). Alex Slovic, Daniel Chu and Christoph Palmanshofer also competed in the main singles draw, however only Palmanshofer advanced past the first round, upsetting Stanford's KC Corkery, 6-3, 6-2. Freshman Michael Ricks had a successful weekend in


the Invitational draws, notching two wins in the singles bracket and two more in the doubles bracket with partner Chris Floyd.

Huskies Top Lobos: The Huskies opened their 10th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance with a solid 4-0 first round win over New Mexico at the Taube Tennis Center on the Stanford University campus. UW took the 1-0 lead after the doubles teams of Alex Vlaski and Daniel Chu, and Alex Slovic and Nick Weiss won their matches to earn the doubles point. In singles, Christoph Palmanshofer had the clinching match for the Huskies in the No. 4 position, defeating Henry Gers in straight-sets, 7-6(1), 6-4. Slovic and Peter Scharler earned the other two singles wins for the Dawgs.

Stanford Stops Huskies: Washington's bid for a fourth-straight trip to the NCAA Sweet 16 was thwarted by Pac-10 foe Stanford, 4-2. in the NCAA regional on the Cardinal home court. Washington jumped out to an early 1-0 lead by winning the doubles point. Christoph Palmanshofer and Peter Scharler captured the first win with an 8-6 decision at the No. 3 position. At the No. 2 doubles spot, Stanford's KC Corkery and Phil Sheng led 7-5, but UW's tandem of Nick Weiss and Alex Slovic rolled off four straight games for the 9-7 win. However, from that point only Palmanshofer could manage a win in singles over Sheng at No. 4 singles. Stanford's James Pade posted a three-set comeback to defeat Scharler in the No. 5 position and clinch the Stanford victory. "It was a very good match. I think we were disappointed that we had lost, but at the same time I think we recognized that the match seemed to be score-wise very similar to a lot of other matches for us last year against top-10 teams."

Three Huskies Make NCAAs: On the individual front Alex Vlaski and Alex Slovic qualified in singles and Vlaski and Daniel Chu qualified in doubles for the individual NCAA Championships in May. Vlaski, who had reached the semifinals the year before, defeated William & Mary's Jeff Kader in the first round but was upset by Nicholas Monroe of North Carolina, 6-3, 6-4, in the second round. Slovic came back from a set down against BYU's 45th-ranked Erik Nyman to win his first round match 5-7, 6-3, 7-6. His run was ended in the second round by Florida's 12thranked Hamid Mirzadeh. In doubles, Vlaski and Chu were knocked out in the first round by Jeremy Wurtzman and Joey Atas of Ohio State.

Slovic ITA Rookie of the Year: Vlaski was not the only left-handed "Alex" from Yugoslavia that dominated on the singles courts last season. Alex Slovic, a childhood friend of Vlaski's, finished his first season as the nation's highest-ranked freshman and was named ITA National Rookie of the Year. He finished the season with a 27-8 singles record. and advanced to the second round of the NCAA tournament. Slovic also led the Huskies in doubles wins with 23. His 19-4 dual record at No. 2 singles was the highest winning percentage on the team. Slovic was also named Co-Pac-10 Freshman of the Year and was the only freshman on the All-Pac-10 First Team.



Post-Season Honors: At season's end, Washington received numerous awards for their on-court play and work in the classroom. Alex Vlaski and Alex Slovic were each named to the All-Pac-10 first team, making Washington the only school with two players on the first unit. Slovic was also named Co-Pac-10 Freshman of the Year along with Stanford's James Wan and was the only freshman on the Pac-10 first team. Vlaski received his second straight Pac-10 All-Academic first team award. Senior Nick Weiss ioined Vlaski on the first team and Peter Scharler earned second team status. Vlaski's academic prowess also earned him a second team selection on the CoSIDA Academic All-District VIII Men's At-Large Team. National recognition also came the Huskies way, as Vlaski earned his second consecutive All-America certificate in singles and Slovic earned the distinctive honor of ITA National Rookie of the Year. Postseason accolades were not limited to the UW players, as longtime Husky mentor Gordon O'Reilly was named ITA Region 8 Assistant Coach of the Year. It was a fitting send-off for O'Reilly who resigned after 11 years at Washington to pursue other business opportunities.


