The University of Washington teams up with Nike to host the 10th-annual Husky Invitational Tournament in 2004. All four Invitational competitors played in the NCAA Tournament last spring. Joining the Huskies are playoff teams Ohio State, Penn State and Portland.

Washington captured its own tournament title the last years, winning back-to-back crowns in 2002 and 2003 for the first time since 1995-96. UW won the first three Husky Invitational Tournament championships from 1994-1996 while Portland claimed four straight from 1997-2001. The tournament took a one-year hiatus in 2000.

The Huskies are 12-4-2 in all-time Nike Tournament play, outscoring opponents 48-20 in those matches.
