



HOPE SOLO

Goalkeeper Hope Solo concluded her collegiate career in 2002 as the most decorated player in Husky history. Solo played for the Philadelphia Charge of the WUSA in 2003 and played with the Kopparbergs/Goteborg club in Sweden. She was the third goalkeeper as an alternate on the 2004 U.S. Women's Olympic Team in Athens.

A senior in 2002, Solo was the the fourth selection overall in the WUSA Draft and the first goalkeeper chosen.

Solo left Washington as the school's leader in nearly every goalkeeping category, including career saves (325), shutouts (18) and goals against average (1.02) along with single-season goals against average (0.68 in 2001).

A four-time all-conference selection, Solo received the Pac-10 Player of the Year award following the 2001 season.

In each of her final two years, Solo was one of 13 finalists for the Hermann Award that honors the national Player of the Year.

Several times during her collegiate career, Solo left to train with the U.S. National Team. She collected seven caps in the process.

TINA FRIMPONG

When Tina Frimpong's stunning four-year collegiate career was completed, she owned almost every Washington goal-scoring record. She then began playing as a defender with the U.S. Women's National Team, earning two caps during the summer of 2005.

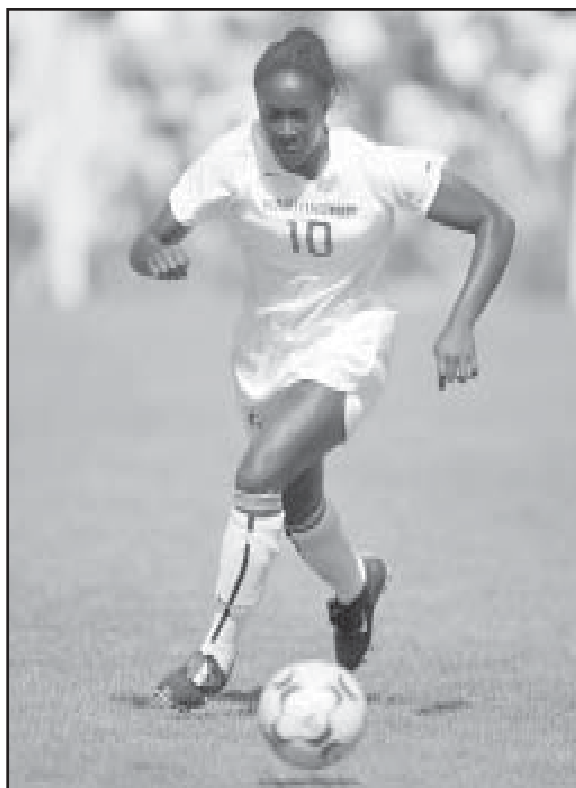
Frimpong accomplished what no other athlete had ever done, becoming the first two-time winner of the Pac-10 Player of the Year award. She first won the top conference honor in 2003, the same year she collected third-team All-America accolades.

In 2004, Frimpong again won the Pac-10's most prestigious award along with second-team All-America acclaim. She helped the team advance deeper into the NCAA Tournament bracket than any previous UW unit as the 2004 squad reached the quarterfinals. Frimpong ushered the Huskies into the Elite Eight with four goals during postseason play, including two game winners.

When her career statistics were compiled, Frimpong stood as the school's all-time career leader with 43 goals, 99 points and 18 game-winning goals. Her 2004 season put her in the record books for UW single-season goals (16), game-winning goals (8) and total points (37).

2004 Season Recap -- Road to the NCAA Quarterfinals

The 2004 season marked the start of Coach Leslie Gallimore's second decade of service at Washington. The Huskies marked the occasion with one of their best seasons ever.

UW registered a 17-5-1 record, placing third in the Pac-10 with a 5-3-1 mark.

Highlighting the regular season were three consecutive season-opening 2-1 wins over ranked foes Penn State, Ohio State and Tennessee. That ignited a run of eight consecutive victories to start the season. UW tied its best ever non-conference ledger with a 9-1 record.

The Huskies had an outstanding 7-2 record against ranked opponents, including a 2-0 win at No. 6 Portland. UW ended the regular season with back-to-back 1-0 wins over No. 14 Stanford and No. 13 California.

But it was after the regular season concluded that the fireworks really started.

The Huskies swept through three straight NCAA Tournament opponents without allowing a goal en route to their first ever quarterfinal berth. UW blanked Birmingham-Southern 5-0 before winning 1-0 at Auburn on a goal by Kelley Schweighart.

The tournament committee rewarded the Huskies with a home game in the Sweet 16 and they defeated Maryland 1-0 on a goal by Tina Frimpong.

The dream season ended one game shy of the Final Four as UW lost 3-1 at Princeton in the Elite Eight.

The secret to Washington's success was to win the close ones. UW won 11 games by a one-goal margin, including six 1-0 victories. Five times games went into overtime with the Huskies netting four golden goals en route to a 4-0-1 record in extra-session contests.

Sparking the success in close games was goalkeeper Kelsey Rasmussen who compiled a school single-season record 10 shutouts. She played every minute of every game in goal.

The 2004 campaign marked the end of the Tina Frimpong era at Washington. The four-year starter departed as the most decorated player in Husky history.

Frimpong was the Pac-10's first two-time Player of the Year award recipient. She completed her UW career as the school's all-time leader in goals (43), game-winning goals (18) and total points (99). Frimpong also owns UW single-season record for goals (16), game-winning goals (8) and total points (37).

Also garnering Pac-10 honors were senior midfielders Nikki Gamble (second team) and Kelley Schweighart (honorable mention) and junior forward Kim Taylor (honorable mention). They helped UW go the entire season without getting shut out for the first time in school history.
