WASHINGTON HEAD COACH HEATHER TARR

Opening comment:

"Obviously we don't take the easy road anywhere we go. I don't think that we could have gotten through today having not gone through what we did to get here. We did an awesome job coming back after a tough emotional loss today. It speaks volumes of what our team is about from the seniors on down to the freshmen. I'm just proud to be associated with all of these awesome young people."

On the performance of the SEC teams in the tournament:

"I think it's great for the game that it's not just two Pac-10 teams playing, but I'm pretty consumed with our team and what we are trying to do. It's nine girls named Sally that we play and I don't really have a broad focus right now."

On freshman Niki Williams and Washington's offense:

"It's an entire team effort. I think our team believes that if Ash (Ashley Charters) doesn't get it done then Kimi's (Pohlman) going to get it done. In front of Ashley is Niki (Williams). Niki just passes the bat and turns it back to the top of the lineup. It's kind of fun seeing that happen."

On her pitching for the day:

"Georgia is a great team and they are definitely one of the best offensive teams that I have faced. That's the fifth time that I have faced them this year, so if they weren't really on to me they wouldn't deserve to be here. They can hit great pitching."

On today's emotions:
