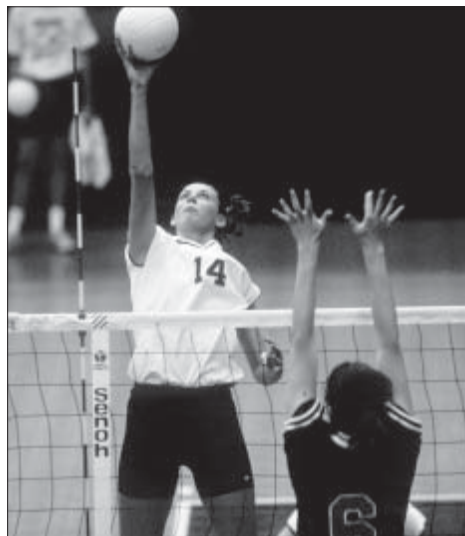

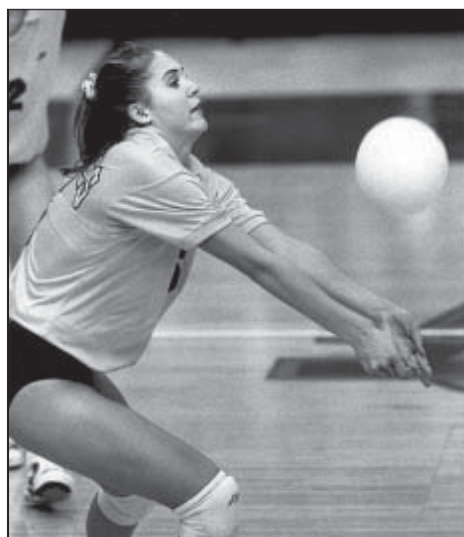

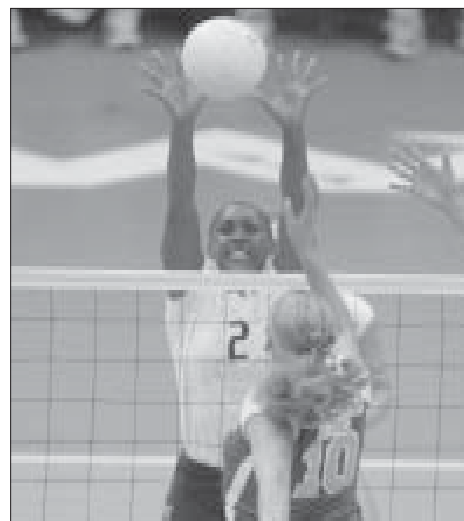

She holds six UW single-season and career block records and was a two-year member of the U.S. National Team (1998, 99).

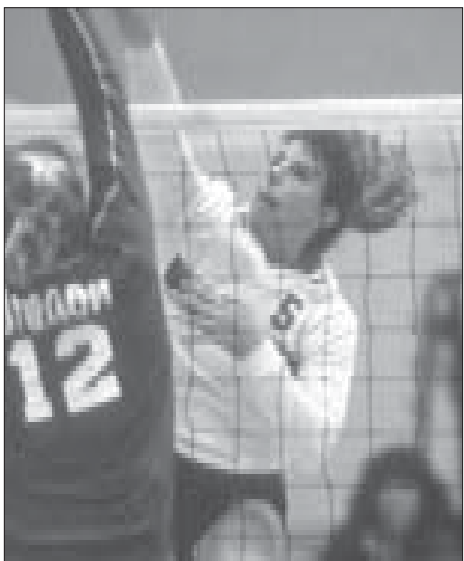
