TRENDING HUSKIES

- **Austin Rei** has reached base in all 16 games he has played this season. He is hitting .349 (14x43) with 4 HR, 10 RBI since returning April 17 after missing 29 games due to surgery on his left thumb.
- The trio of **Spencer Jones** (51.1), **Brandon Choate** (48.2) and **Troy Rallings** (44.1) has accounted for 144.1innings of the bullpen's total of 180.0, or about 80%. In 16 April games, the trio threw all but 2.0 innings of the bullpen's total of 61.0 during the month.
- **Alex Schmidt** hit .375 with 8 multi-hit games in April to raise his average from .207 to .281. He is 3x8 in May and is now up to .286 on the year.
- **Branden Berry** is tied for 4th in the Conference with 7 HR and T10th with 33 RBI. He had 4 homers and 14 RBI in April.
- **Braden Bishop** is hitting .348 (23x66) with 17 runs in road games. He is also hitting .315 vs. right-handed pitchers.
- **Ryan Schmitt** is 1-1 with a 3.32 ERA over 21.2 IP in 5 games as a starter. In 7 relief appearances, he is 0-0 with a 7.27 ERA over 8.2 IP.

Washington (24-21, 9-15) at Arizona (27-18, 11-13)

Washington wraps up the road portion of its schedule this weekend with three games in Tucson against Arizona. The Huskies (24-21, 9-15 Pac-12) have a better record on the road this season than at home. They are 12-6 entering the weekend, ensuring themselves of a winning record on the road for a second-consecutive season. The Wildcats (27-18, 11-13) had lost seven in a row at home, including sweeps by USC and Cal, before beating Arizona State in a non-conference game last Tuesday. Arizona is coming off winning two of three at Washington State last weekend. This weekend's three-game series is being telecast by the Pac-12 Networks with **Rich Celini** and **J.T. Snow** on the call.

UW-ARIZONA UNITE TO PLAY 4MOM

UW junior outfielder **Braden Bishop** has been paying homage to his mom Suzy's battle against early-onset Alzheimer's disease by writing 4MOM on his wrist and on his shoes all season long. After reaching out to Arizona's **Scott Kingery**, who Bishop played summer baseball with in the Cape Cod League, both teams will pay homage to their moms in their own way on Mother's Day this Sunday by writing 4MOM on their wrists and equipment. Before the season, Bishop held a fundraiser to help in the research of Alzheimer's and continues to try to raise awareness of the disease with his 4MOM campaign.

SERIES HISTORY VS. ARIZONA

Arizona leads the series 28-23 all time. Last season, the Huskies swept the Wildcats in the grand opening of Husky Ballpark. It marked the Huskies first sweep of the Wildcats since 2004. Washington has now won the last two series against Arizona. When the two teams last met in Tucson in 2013, the Huskies outscored the Wildcats 28-7, including a 23-1 win on May 3 -- which is the largest home loss in Arizona history -- and won the series 2-1. In the previous visit to Arizona, the Wildcats swept the Huskies in 2011. Coach Lindsay Meggs is 7-8 against the Wildcats in his previous five years at UW.

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT UW:

- **Davis' Nearing Innings Pitched Record:** If senior **Tyler Davis** sticks to form, he will pass **Tim Lincecum's** team record for innings pitched of 342 during his start on Saturday. Davis, who has pitched at least 6.0 innings in each start this season, is four innings shy of tying Lincecum's record. He is also poised to move into 4th all-time with 74 appearances and will move to within one start of tying for second all-time with **Jeff Carlsen** (49). If he can win on Saturday, he will tie for fourth all-time with 22 career wins. [Complete lists on Page 5 of notes.](#)
- **Getting Defensive:** The Huskies enter the weekend leading the Pac-12 in team fielding, with a percentage of .977. They have committed 41 errors in 1,771 chances. Individually, **Branden Berry** leads all players with 455 chances and is second with 425 putouts. **Levi Jordan** leads all starting middle infielders with a fielding percentage of .994, committing just one error in 177 chances. **Joey Morgan** is statistically the second hardest catcher in the nation to steal against, throwing out 17 would-be stealers in 32 chances (.531).
- **Oh So Close:** Of the Huskies 15 Pac-12 losses, 10 are by one-run and two are by two runs. The Huskies are 3-10 in one-run games overall with the 10 one-run losses in Conference play representing the most since the balanced schedules were introduced in 1999. UW is also 0-6 in extra-inning games in Pac-12 play.

COACH MEGGS: Lindsay Meggs, the 2014 Pac-12 Coach of the Year, is in his sixth season as head coach at Washington. He is 164-160-1 at Washington and 779-467-5 in his 21st overall season. At the start of the year, his career win total ranked 33rd among all active NCAA coaches, 4th among Pac-12 coaches. In 2014, Meggs led UW to its highest ranking ever, its best Conference finish since 2004 and its first NCAA appearance since that same year. UW's 21 Pac-12 wins were the second most in school history. A school record eight Huskies were selected in the 2014 MLB Draft. Meggs came to the UW after having spent the previous three seasons at Indiana State and the 13 prior to that at Chico State, where he won NCAA Division II national championships in 1997 and 1999. He helped Chico to the D-II College World Series seven times and won the league eight times. At Indiana State, he was named Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year in 2009 after guiding the Sycamores to a 2nd-place finish, their highest since 1998. Born in San Jose and a graduate of Saratoga (Calif.) High, Meggs played four seasons at third baseman for UCLA. He was drafted by the Brewers in 1983, and then again by the Royals after his senior year in 1984. Meggs' assistants are **Jason Kelly**, **Donegal Fergus** and **Tanner Swanson**.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Huskies opened new 2,400 seat Husky Ballpark last season. The park features permanent seating for the first time, open main-level concourses with views of the field from every vantage and a top floor concourse that houses a press box, radio and TV booths, club seating and an AD booth. In addition, there is a new video board, a full complement of restrooms and concessions, plus new field turf.

SQUAD BREAKDOWN: Among the 35 players on the 2014 Husky roster, there are five seniors, 10 juniors, 6 sophomores and 14 freshmen. The squad includes 18 returners and 17 newcomers (10 true freshmen, 4 redshirt freshmen, 3 JC transfers). The roster includes players from six different states. Of the 35 players on the roster entering the season, 11 are from Washington, 19 are from California, two are from Idaho and one each from Nevada, Oregon and Montana. Washington's baseball roster has traditionally been heavily dominated by in-state players. Of the 11 players from the Evergreen State, 10 come from west of the Cascade Mountains, (the western half of the state).
